- Communicates with a diverse group of students and parents
- Provides a fun and creative environment
- Other duties as assigned by the head coach and/or director of athletics

- Prior coaching and or teaching experience
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Energy, drive, creativity, and dependability
