To Athletic Director and Golf Coaches:

The purpose of this letter is to provide key dates and general rules for the Spring 2023 Virginia Independent Schools Athletic Association (VISAA) Varsity Golf season.

The VSGA will host a rules seminar via Zoom 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM on March 15th. Coaches, parents, and players are encouraged to attend. Here is a link to the seminar: <https://register.gotowebinar.com/register/3662321928978893398>. Please pass the information to anyone interested in attending.

Each division has a contact throughout the season. Division I: Coach Jeff Dunnington (jdunnington@collegiate-va.org); Division II: Coach Mark Priebe (mpriebe@gofcs.org); Division III: Coach Keith Green (Kgreen@faculty.kenston.org).

The VISAA State championship will be held on May 15, 2023 (rain date May 22, 2023) at Meadowbrook Country Club, 3700 Cogbill Road, Richmond, VA.

The cost will be \$25 per player. Payments must be paid prior to the first tee time.

The second annual 9-hole Girl's Invitational will be held at Meadowbrook Country Club on May 10, 2023. Coaches will submit names with a scoring summary to the committee by April 28th.

There is no cost to participate in the Girl's Invitational.

State tournament qualifications for teams and individual athletes:

- Teams and individuals must complete a minimum 6 matches to be eligible for the state championship.
- Coaches must report match scores by 9:00 PM Saturday evening. Here is the link to report match scores:

Important State Tournament Information:

Scores will be used to select teams and individuals. We will not use handicaps.

Failure to submit scores will disqualify the team from participating in the state championship.

- The Committee will rank teams throughout the season within the three divisions beginning the first week in April. The final ranking will be released on May 9, 2023. The top 6 teams in each Division will be invited to the State tournament.
- Coaches should keep a record of individual scores. The top 4 players in each division not on an invited team will be invited as an individual. Coaches will nominate individuals; the committee will announce individual selections May 9, 2023, after the teams are selected.
- Boys should play from 6500–6700 yards; girls should play from 5500-5700 yards.
