Play will be in accordance with USGA Rules, the VSGA Standard Local Rules and the following local rules. Penalty for breach of a local rule is a general penalty, unless otherwise noted.

Tee Markers: All Boys - **BLACK** tee markers; All Girls - **GOLD** tee markers.

Format: 18-hole stroke play. Each team total is determined by using the low 4 of 6 scores on each team. **The maximum score to count for each player on each hole is double par.**

Ties: Only ties for first and second place in the team competition will be broken using the following: (1) the fifth lowest score of the teams; (2) the sixth lowest score of the teams; (3) the lowest individual score of the teams; (4) the lowest individual scores on individual holes, starting with the #1 handicap hole, until the tie is broken.

Alternative to Stroke and Distance: Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule E-5.

Dropping Zones: Hole #9 (right of cart path), hole #16 (short right of putting green) and hole #17 (forward tee, approximately 103 yards) - As an additional option when taking relief under Rule 17.1, players may use the dropping zone provided.

Out of Bounds: Out of bounds is defined by white stakes and fence posts. The margin is determined by the inside edge at ground level of white stakes and fence posts.

Advice: Model Local Rule H-2 is in effect for this competition. Each team may appoint two people who may give advice to members of that team. Advice may not be given when a player's ball lie on the putting green. First offense - warning; second offense - one stroke penalty; third and subsequent offenses - general penalty.

Player Shuttles: During the round, players must walk at all times unless riding in a Committee provided shuttle.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the championship website for the complete pace of play policy. The allotted time is 4 hours and 30 minutes.

Rules Committee: Players may only receive rulings from the following individuals: Larry Blasch, Toby Heitzler, Amanda Kelley, Janet Phillips, Bill Preston, and Andrew Wagner.
