I hope you all are having a good Summer! I am pleased to announce that the **2024 VISAA Cross Country Championships** will be held in Earlysville this coming Fall at Panorama Farms.

SITE INFORMATION:

- Site: Panorama Farms, 400 Panorama Road, Earlysville, VA 22936
- Date: Thursday, November 7, 2024
- Start: 11:00 AM; course opens at 9:30 AM;
 - Once races start, runners that are not in the race are not allowed to be on the course.
- Porta Johns are available on site;
- Concessions will be made available.

DIVISION ALIGNMENT: This is the first year of the two year cycle (2024 - 2026) divisional classification based on the number of students submitted in September 2023. As a reminder this year's championships will be three divisions. ADMISSION FEE: VISAA will charge a fee of \$10.00 for admission for the Championships. Please make parents aware of this policy. Tickets must be purchased on GoFan. A ticket is the only way to get onto the meet site for spectators.

ENTRY FEE: If you have a full team (5 or more runners the price is \$100 per gender. If you are only running individuals the price is \$10. If you are a coed school with a full team on both sides, the cost is \$200. Entries fees should be paid prior to the state championships by Wednesday, November 6, 2024.

DRESSING: All competitors are asked to arrive at the course dressed. We are asking that all runners be in the same uniform/similar to all runners on the team. Locker rooms and towels **will not be available**. There will be porta-johns on site.

ENTRIES: Entries will be done online at milestat.com. Please submit entries by **midnight Sunday November 3, 2024**. (There is a limit of 10 entries per school per gender 2 alternates are included in that total number of 10).

- <u>Boys 25 minute time limit</u> across all three divisions; **all entries** have to meet the requirement (including alternates).
- <u>Girls 30 minute time limit</u> across all three divisions; **all entries** have to meet the requirement (including alternates).
- As a reminder, for any athlete that qualifies by time, must have <u>three completed races at the 5K</u> <u>distance</u>. We stress this as we know some invitationals will only allow 8th grade runners to compete at the middle school level.
- All entries are required to be entered on MILESTAT.
- **Password** for the meet is VISAAXC2024

Each runner must have three timed results by a system not by hand timing. This will be verified throughout the season.

COACHES/ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL -All coaches must check in at the COACHES TENT to pick up their information. All teams are required to have a coach or volunteer at the finish to deal with any possible medical issues at the finish line and to assist runners through the chute. Instruct your runners to continue moving through the chute, do not let them stop at the finish line.

TENTS: Team tents can be set- up in the assigned areas, we will provide a map from Panorama Farms as we get closer to the date.

TRASH: Teams are responsible for picking up after themselves.

PARKING: BUS DRIVERS-Buses will be directed where to park.

MEDICAL POLICY: The top priority of our medical staff is to respond to life threatening medical emergencies. There will be a trainer(s) on site to treat athletes, coaches, and spectators as needed.
