Rules	The Meet will be governed by Swimming and Diving rules for	2023-2024 National Federation High School championship meets.			
Eligibility	<ul> <li>The meet is open to current 8th-12th grade students.</li> <li>Athletes must be in good standing with the school he/she represents.</li> <li>Athletes cannot be older than 19 years of age on August 1, 2023</li> <li>A swimmer must have achieved the VISAA qualifying time established for the events entered. The qualifying time must be swum in a VISAA meet during the current season.         <ul> <li>A VISAA meet is a multi-team meet officiated by certified starter/referee and stroke and turn judges, in which an athlete represents their school.</li> <li>Times must be recorded with either a touchpad or at least two watches.</li> <li>Times swum in a single team time trial do not count.</li> </ul> </li> <li>To ensure promotion of High School Swimming student-athletes must participate</li> </ul>				

in at least half of their team's in-season meets.

- Waivers may be requested from a committee that consists of: Meet Director(s),
   VISAA Swim Chair, Head Referee, and Diving Coordinator (if applicable).
- Waivers may be allowed in limited cases, including:
  - Swimmers involved in school sponsored exchange programs
  - Prolonged sickness or other approved medical reasons.
- Waivers must be submitted by Monday, January 29th to VISAA Swimming Co-Chairs, Kaitlyn Gerke and Mike Peters.

### **Entry Rules**

#### • Individual Events

- Any eligible swimmer who has swum the qualifying time <u>during the</u>
   2023-2024 season may be entered in that individual event.
- Each team is allowed unlimited entries in individual events, but only a team's top four (4) qualifiers are eligible for finals.
  - In the event any team qualifies more than 4 swimmers in the top 16 during prelims, the coach must designate which 4 swimmers will compete in finals. Designations are due to the timing & scoring operator prior to the end of prelims.
- An individual swimmer may swim no more than two (2) individual events and no more than four (4) total events, including relays.

#### Bonus 50 Free

- Any swimmer that qualified for the meet in an individual or relay event, and meets the Bonus qualification time, is eligible to enter the Bonus 50 Freestyle.
- Entry in the event will count toward a swimmer's event total.
- Bonus event swimmers are not eligible to score points in the event.
- A relay only swimmer entered in the bonus 50 free must participate in at least one relay.

#### Relays

- Each team that had a relay swim the qualifying time during the season may enter a single "A" relay in that relay event.
- Swimmers who participated in a relay during the season that meets the VISAA State qualifying time are eligible to swim in that relay.
- Swimmers who qualified for an individual event, including diving, are eligible to swim in any relay at States.
- Each team may enter one exhibition "B" Relay in any relay event, but every swimmer on that relay must have <u>qualified either</u> <u>individually or on a relay that met the qualifying time during the</u> <u>season.</u> "B" Relays may not score.
- Relays may be entered without swimmers' names, but final relay cards are due prior to the race.
- Swimmers who participate in a "B" Relay during the preliminary session may compete in an "A" Relay of the same event during finals. This will still count as 1 event for the swimmer.

#### Relay Cards

- All Relay Cards (200 Medley, 200 Free, 400 Free) specifying the relay line-up shall be submitted 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
- Swimmers whose names are submitted on the relay cards must swim that event, in the order listed on the card, unless the Meet Referee

- allows for a substitution.
- Any team that does not submit a relay card by the deadline must swim the relay as listed in the meet program.
- If enforcement of this regulation causes a swimmer's total event count to exceed four (4) total events, the swimmer/relay is subject to the following NFHS regulation:
  - The competitor(s) is/are disqualified from that event and further competition.
- The competitor(s) shall not be disqualified from events in subsequent rounds for which he/she has previously, legally qualified.

## Entry Submission

#### All entries must be submitted to Swimcloud by Sunday, February 11, 11:59pm.

- Go to the <u>Home page of the VISAA Swimming & Diving State Championship</u> webpage.
- Select either:
  - Add entries by event
  - Add entries by swimmer
- Entries must include first and last name, gender, grade level and seed times.
   Seed times should be actual or converted short-course yard times that meet the qualifying standards.
- Entry times must be in results of a meet that has been uploaded to Swimcloud.
  - <u>Click here</u> for SwimCloud meet upload instructions.
- Except for relays, all entries are final once they are submitted.
- The final psych sheet will be published on SwimCloud, Wednesday, February 14
- No changes can be made to the preliminary psych sheet after it's published.
   Only clerical corrections will be allowed.
- All entries, including divers, must be submitted in Swimcloud. No HyTek, manual or hardcopy entries will be accepted.
- Meet entry fees: \$6.00/individual event; \$30.00/relay; \$5.00/athlete surcharge; \$400 cap per team
  - An invoice will be sent directly to the Athletic Director of each participating school in order to collect each team's entry fees following the VISAA meet.

#### **DIVING**

- Qualifications
  - Divers may qualify in one of the two following ways.
    - 1. Obtain an 11-dive score of 200 points. Divers must submit a score sheet that proves all 11 dives were executed successfully with no failed dives.
    - 2. Obtain a 6-dive score of 140 points. Divers must submit a score sheet that proves all 6 dives were executed successfully with no failed dives. Additionally, coaches must prove the diver can successfully perform 11 dives by submitting video clips of the remaining 5 dives in their 11 dive list. Videotaped dives must be worth a score of 2.5 or higher.

# Any coach may file a protest with the Head Referee for matters not specifically covered by the rules or a misapplication of the rules. Judgment calls are not subject to protest.

- Concerns over Stroke and Turn disqualifications may be referred to the Head Referee but cannot be protested unless the concern is a misapplication of the rules.
- If such an event occurs, a "Meet Committee" consisting of; the VISAA
   President, VISAA Meet Director (for swimming and administrative issues)
   or Diving Coordinator (for diving issues), the VISAA Regional
   Representatives and Secretary, will have the authority to settle disputes.
- The Meet Committee will have the original disqualification explained to them with all involved parties present, after which anyone else that wishes to speak will have their opportunity.
- Once the committee convenes and reaches a final decision, the VISAA President will communicate the decision.

Competition Swimsuits and Caps	<ul> <li>Prior to the 2010 meet, the National Federation of High Schools announced that speed suits are banned from high school competition.         <ul> <li>All suits must be made of a textile fabric.</li> <li>Boys can only wear jammers or briefs – nothing above the waist or below the knee will be allowed.</li> <li>Girls cannot wear suits that cover the shoulders or go below the knee. Suits cannot have zippers or other fasteners.</li> <li>Swimmers may only wear one suit during the competition.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Only school or manufacturer logos should be visible on swimsuits and swim caps. Club team caps are not allowed.</li> </ul>
